BASIC

To be eligible to attend an Emergency Care Practitioner course at EMTSS you must:

- a) Be a minimum of 18 years of age at the **beginning** date of the course.
- b) Be proficient in **reading, writing, and speaking** the **English language (Minimum of D Symbol) in Grade 10 or pass an English proficiency evaluation (at own cost)**. A Class A First Aid certificate might be recommended.
- c) Minimum **23 Points in Grade 10**.
- d) Have no physical or mental impairment that would render them unable to perform all practical skills required for that level of certification.
- e) Have **no dependencies on drugs** (Cocaine, alcohol, opioids, or any other substance that may affect judgment, patient treatment and / or ability to function as a paramedic)
- f) Be physically fit and able to successfully pass a physical fitness test (on request) (include but not limited to shuttle run (Time dependant), push-ups, sit-ups, step-ups, and body carry / pickup (Minimum of 50 Kg))

EMERGENCY CARE PRACTITIONER COURSE TERMS AND CONDITIONS

1. **A formal purchase order or proof of payment is required as acceptance of a quotation.** No verbal acceptances will be used to book training.
2. **Course bookings will only be made once a fully completed booking form has been received by EMTSS with proof of payment for the training as per payment agreement.**
3. **Failure to provide proof of payment will result in the forfeiture of any reserved dates.**
4. Course fees **do not** include travel, accommodation, flights, visas, site establishment or any other costs that might be incurred by the student / candidate to be at the venue for training.
5. Prices stated on the price list and quoted on are subject to change without prior notice.
6. Prices are quoted including vat unless otherwise stated. **Prices outside of Windhoek** will differ based on distance, mode of travel, venue, and accommodation.
7. The period of validity for a quotation is 30 days unless otherwise stated.
8. Dates for **unconfirmed bookings** are subject to change without prior notice.
9. **If fewer candidates than the amount stated on the order, or no candidates, are present at any time of the course then the course order will be invoiced** as per the placed order according to the bookings form or purchase order.
10. If **insufficient numbers of candidates** are confirmed for a booked course, the **dates are subject to change.**
11. **Candidates will not receive their certificates or be registered without full payment being received.**

Candidates are required to ensure capability to perform the required skills on all training courses and may be requested to produce a certificate of medical fitness before training commences and those who are requested but fail to do so will be refused acceptance onto a course.
17. No pregnant woman will be accepted onto any course/s – e.g., Working at Heights, Rope rescue techniques, Emergency Care Practitioner Basic & Intermediate, or any course that is considered dangerous to the fetus or mother.
18. The instructions of a facilitator, while candidates are performing skills, are always to be obeyed.
19. Candidates are not permitted to be involved with other tasks for the duration of the training.
20. Candidates are to provide their own meals and refreshments for the duration of the training, unless otherwise arranged.
21. Candidates must arrive prepared for training (including partaking in practical sessions – could mean lying on the floor to simulate a patient, putting out a fire, climbing a structure) and be dressed appropriately.
22. Where enough candidate information has not been provided (i.e., copy of ID, telephone number, and employer), EMTSS will not accept responsibility for delays in certification.
23. All training is delivered in **ENGLISH**, unless otherwise arranged. Should the candidate not be able to read or write English, then it is the clients' responsibility to inform the EMTSS training coordinator in advance of possible communication barriers and provide a translator for their candidates at their own cost.

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Emergency Management Training Course Outline

EMERGENCY CARE PRACTITIONER – BASIC

The Emergency Care Practitioner - Basic Course is designed to assess a patient's condition, and to perform such emergency medical procedures as are needed to maintain a patent airway with adequate breathing and cardiovascular circulation until the patient can be transferred to an appropriate destination for advanced medical care or advanced life support arrives on scene of the emergency. Interventions include cardiopulmonary resuscitation, External Automated Defibrillation, controlling severe external bleeding, preventing shock, body immobilization to prevent spinal damage, splinting of fractures, and assisting with childbirth. ECP - Basic are trained in basic life support. The course is presented towards the objective to achieve a theoretical background (110 Hours) and practical application (50 Hours classroom skills). Assessment is done through theoretical and practical evaluation to test the competence in Cognitive and Psychomotor Domains.

Our Emergency Care Practitioner - Basic course covers the following topics:

Module 1 - Preparatory

- Topics covered in this module are EMS systems, the role of the ECP-Basic, the safety and well-being of the ECP-Basic, legal and ethical issues, basic anatomy and physiology, techniques of lifting and moving patients.

Module 2 - Airway Management

- Topics covered in this module are airway anatomy, airway management techniques, oxygen, and oxygen equipment.

Module 3 - Patient Assessment

- Topics covered in this module are assessment of the medical and trauma patients, vital sign assessment, taking a patient history, documentation, and communication.

Module 4 - Medical Emergencies

- Topics covered in this module are pharmacology, respiratory, cardiac, diabetic, allergy, poisoning and overdose, environmental, behavioural, obstetrical / gynaecological emergencies, geriatric emergencies.

Module 5 - Trauma Emergencies

- Topics covered in this module are bleeding and shock, soft tissue and musculoskeletal injuries, injuries to the head, neck, spine, chest, and abdomen.

Module 6 - Infants & Children

- Topics covered in this module are physical and physiological differences between adult and paediatric patients, paediatric medical and trauma emergencies.

Module 7 - Operations

- Topics covered in this module are ambulance operations, rescue and extrication, multiple patient situations, hazardous materials situations.

Module 8 - OPTIONAL / ADD ON

- CPR for All (CPR and AED)
 - Additional certificate for course completed in module 8
